# A SUMMARY

- It is a short version of a larger writing (article, chapter, book, etc.)
- A summary consists of only the original author's opinion, NOT OUR OPINION.

# Let's write a summary

- Based on your notes on the right margin, write down a short summary (+/- 100 words) about the article titled “No More Building Malls in Jakarta”.
- Remember: Always refer to your notes, not the original text to avoid the tendency to plagiarize.

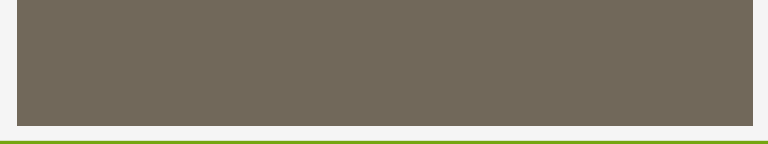
1. Read the article about "Parks" again [3-3 Park.doc](#)
